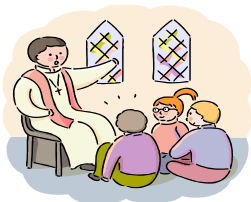
### Wednesday Afterschool Café

you are required to pick the children up immediately. If the federal government opens one or two hours late, NLC will open 1 HOUR LATE.

When LCPS's are closed due to holidays/teacher work days and the NLC is open, school age children may attend for an extra fee. The extra fee is applied if the child arrives before their normal time i.e. 11 am for kindergarten or 2:45 for 1st - 5th grade.
