<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Walk up and down stairs, alternating feet</li> <li>• Jump in place</li> <li>• Begin balancing on one foot</li> <li>• Begin hopping on one foot</li> <li>• Gallop</li> <li>• Throw a ball forward</li> <li>• Kick a ball forward</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Speak clearly</li> <li>• Communicate in complete sentences</li> <li>• Answer questions</li> <li>• Wait for a turn speaking</li> <li>• Use language to communicate wants and needs</li> <li>• Expand vocabulary</li> <li>• Participate in group singing</li> </ul>
